



At Hydro-Klean, safety always is the first priority. The safety of our employees starts with dedication and hard work. Hydro-Klean employs a professional Health & Safety Manager to work full-time on the health and safety aspects of our daily operations. This allows us to commit full attention to any safety issues or concerns that may come up. Our Health & Safety Manager also is an OSHA General Industry Outreach Trainer, authorized to train in accordance with guidelines provided by the OSHA Training Institute.

At one time or another, every employee serves on the Hydro-Klean Safety Committee. The Safety Committee deals with health and safety issues from the standpoint of our field service staff. This employee involvement puts real substance behind our written safety programs. The committee shares its findings and discussions with the rest of the company, which adds to the overall safety awareness of all employees. We integrate injury and illness prevention with operational systems and decision-making.

Hydro-Klean also performs regular safety audits to identify risks before incidents occur. By doing this, we can identify defective equipment, update our policies, test employee knowledge and ensure that program goals are being met. Along with auditing, Hydro-Klean works with OSHA consultation to assure that our policies, procedures and programs are in complete regulatory compliance. This gives you the peace of mind knowing the work done on your site is being performed safely and up to OSHA regulations.



Health and Safety

In addition to regulations required by OSHA, Hydro-Klean has developed standards and protocols for safe working practices that are more specific and stringent. We manage a Loss Prevention and Control Plan of written standards. The content of our Loss Prevention and Control Plan is the glue that holds our safety program together, from policy and procedure to training.

Hydro-Klean goes above and beyond what is required for our regulatory training. Our employees receive more than 80 hours of skilled training within their first six months of employment and more than 20 hours of skilled refresher training on a yearly basis. Included in the training at Hydro-Klean are 24-hour confined space entry, 40-hour HAZWOPER, first aid and CPR classes, OSHA 10 hour training and many other subjects taught on a monthly basis.

We consider removal of hazards from the work environment to be the primary means of personal protection. Hydro-Klean will assess each workplace prior to the start of fieldwork to determine if hazards are present and necessitate the use of personal protective equipment (PPE). Hydro-Klean employees are trained on the assessment of procedures, recommended PPE, the limitations of PPE, and the proper use and care of PPE.



Hydro-Klean employees are equipped with the best PPE for the eyes, face, head, extremities, protective clothing, respiratory devices (including self-contained breathing apparatus), protective shields and barriers.

Hydro-Klean will uphold its position as a safety leader by promoting environmental, health and safety excellence. The efficiency of any safe operation can and should be measured by the company's ability to control losses. By this standard, Hydro-Klean always delivers outstanding performance. Our Experience Modification Ratio (EMR) always is below average as is our OSHA recordable incident rate.
